Parish Registration is the official way to join a parish community. Many people think that they automatically belong. At times young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of our parish. Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for tax purposes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in the parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of our parish.



Considering a year-end gift to Our Lady of Fatima? Here's what you need to know.

1. Your gift matters

Through your generosity, Our Lady of Fatima is spreading the knowledge and love of Jesus Christ in Magnolia. Because of you, we welcomed 6 individuals into the Catholic Church this year, hosted 60 children in religious education, and gave 48 households material assistance.

2. If you itemize your deductions

The Adjusted Gross Income limitation for charitable contributions in 2023 is 60%. You can deduct your cash contributions up to this percentage. Making a year-end gift may make you eligible to itemize your deductions.

3. Christmas office hours

Our office will remain open to receive any in-person donations until December 21, 3PM.

4. You can donate online, right up to the last second of 2023!

You can make a gift from home! You can donate to Our Lady of Fatima online at https://www.olfatima.org/donate/. In addition, any gift postmarked by December 31 can be applied to the 2023 calendar year.

5. Other cash-equivalent gifts are accepted!

Stocks, bonds, real estate, and more will be gratefully accepted and immediately used. You **may** be able to avoid capital gains taxes by making such gifts.
