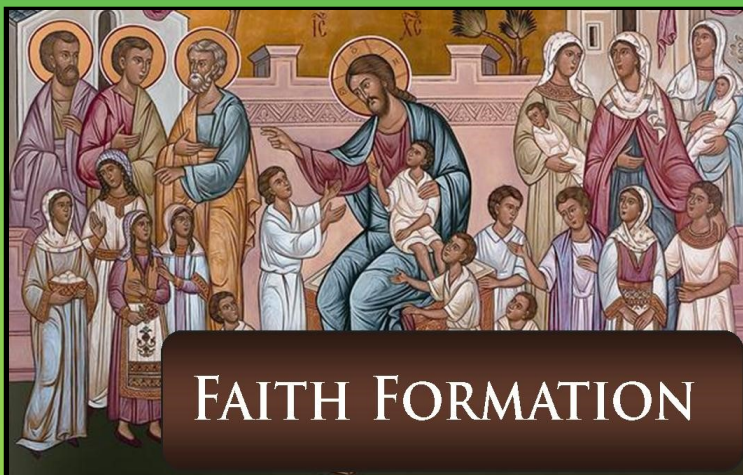

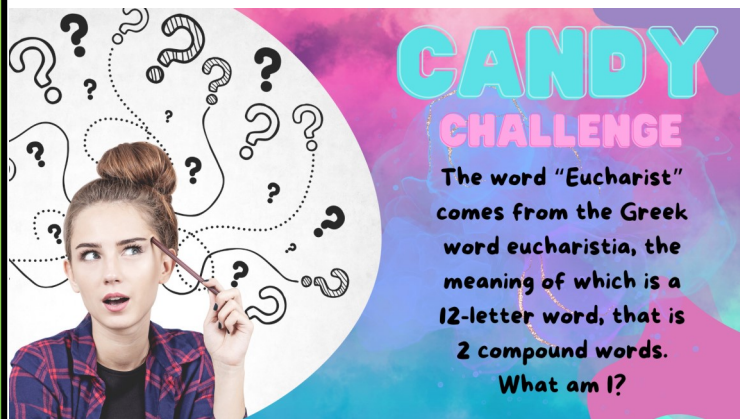
EDGE (Middle School):
