**ST MARTIN'S SHELTER MEAL PROGRAM:**

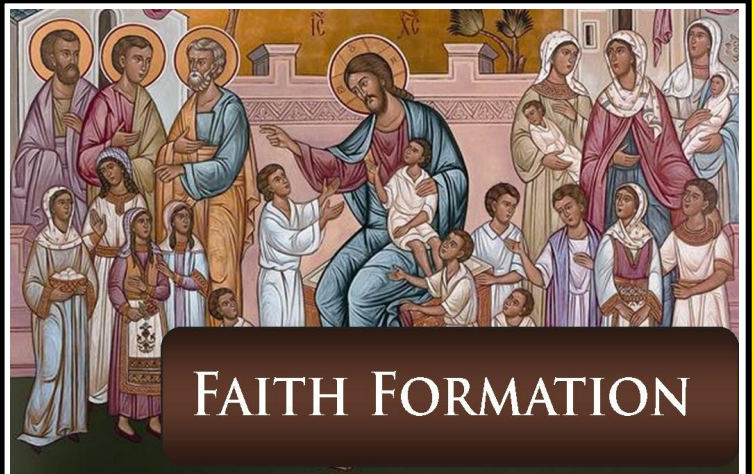
